1. **Airplane** - an aircraft that has a fixed wing and is powered by propellers or jets
2. **Glider** - an aircraft that flies without a motor
3. **Aerodynamic** - Able to move through the air with as little air resistance as possible
4. **Air resistance** - opposes the motion of objects that move through the air
5. **Thrust** - the act of applying force to propel something
6. **Lift** - an upward force
7. **Gravity** - the force that pulls objects toward earth
8. **Force** - A push or pull
9. **Mass** - the amount of matter in an object
10. **Outlier** - a value much greater or much less than the others in a data set
