Magazine Cover

1. Open Photoshop
 2. File >> New >> Preset: U.S.Paper
 3. Need to decide on a background Color
 4. Edit >> Fill >> Select Color >> Press OK
 5. Add your Image to the Background
 6. File >> Open >> Select your image.
 - You can use the rectangular marquee tool to select what part of the image you want to copy & paste to background.
 - You can use the Quick Selection tool to select your image without the background.
- Your image >> Edit >> Cut >> Go to background & Paste
The image will be small >> Edit >> select Free Transform to resize image- hold down shift key to resize image.
